

Rethinking GOD'S Rainbow Marriages | Part 05 | GOD'S Intense Week of Training

Let me tell you a story that I learned from a Wise, Trusted Friend. She's so wise that Her Husband and Son call Her Wisdom. All mistakes in this retelling are mine, not Hers.

- Part 1 -

Back before time started, there was a Good GOD that wanted children to love. He had a plan and weighed the cost. The joy set before Him was so great that it was worth all the pain & heartache it would cause to achieve His goal.

Since His plan called for three roles that could only be accomplished by Him, He split Himself like a cell into three parts, Father GOD, Mother Spirit, and Son Jesus. It wasn't long before a competition developed between Stan and Jesus. Jesus was even more accomplished in solving problems. Soon Father GOD'S first family divided into two teams, Team Stan and Team Jesus. Everyone in Heaven enjoys their own freewill, so disputes do occur. - Part 2 -

- Part 5 -
