

Rethinking GOD'S Rainbow Marriages | Part 13 | Jesus

Why did Jesus teach us to obey the Pharisees & Moses' Law?

After that, Jesus spoke to the crowds and to His disciples. He said, 'The teachers of Moses' Law and the Pharisees have authority to explain the Law of Moses. So you must obey everything that they teach you.'

- King Jesus (While under Moses' Law) in Matthew 23: 1-4 EASY

After He had successfully fulfilled and archived the Mosaic Law, GOD gives instructions to Peter and Paul to disobey the teachers of Moses' Laws and the Pharisees. GOD taught them to discard Jewish dietary requirements and circumcision to be considered Jesus' followers. Is GOD being inconsistent and contradicting Himself or did something change? I propose that after GOD fulfilled Moses' Covenant He was freed from the same chains that had chained up His people under religion. We are now free to choose the Law of Liberty explained by James by how we choose to judge others:

"For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it. [...] Speak and act as those who are going to be judged by the law that gives freedom,"

- James in James 2:10, 12 NIV

It was a big deal for the Early Church to learn they could eat bacon and follow Jesus when they weren't circumcised. Can you imagine Jesus trying to convince Paul & Peter that He created 6% of mankind to be same-sex attracted and they needed to be judged by James' Law of Liberty like everyone else? This perfectly explains Jesus following statement:

"I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear."

- King Jesus in John 16:12 NIV

Two thousand years later, many still can't bear His teachings. Jesus is alive and isn't stingy with His Wisdom. If we lean on Him rather than our own understanding, He can untangle our Biblical confusion. Our Good GOD is not the source of our confusion nor our results of being known for our hatred of GOD'S Rainbow Children rather than our love.

"Wisdom is vindicated and shown to be right by all Her children"

- King Jesus in Luke 7:35 AMP

The following are invitations to come into closer alignment with our GOD, King, and Teacher. I want them to give everyone permission to ask Him directly what He thinks about same-sex marriages. Since our Good GOD is always perfectly consistent, I know that everyone will get a consistent answer. If some hear differently from counterfeit angels of light, they will use fear and manipulation (bad fruit) to obliterate any resistance to their Biblical opinions to retain their control.

Invitation 1: Jesus Teaches Us About Celibacy

But He said to them, "All cannot accept this saying, but only those to whom it has been given: For there are eunuchs who were born thus from their mother's womb, and there are eunuchs who were made eunuchs by men, and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the Kingdom of Heaven's sake. He who is able to accept it, let him accept it."

- King Jesus in Matthew 19:11-12 NKJV

Our Teacher divides celibacy for men into three groups:

- 1) Being born a eunuch
- 2) Made a eunuch by force by ***mankind specifically***, not by GOD
- 3) Made a eunuch by their own freewill choice to advance King Jesus' Kingdom

Notice that this would have been a perfect opportunity for Jesus to add a 4th option like, 'Those that become eunuchs to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.' Instead, the third group is referencing men like Paul who forgo marriage to concentrate on advancing the Kingdom of Heaven, not just getting into it.

One of the things that makes this important is because Jesus didn't miss opportunities like this to make His positions clear to future generations. He knew the end from the beginning and never said or did anything that Father GOD didn't prepare Him to do or say.

The 4th option of GOD forcing men to remain celibate to enter His Kingdom of Heaven is not present. Even if GOD had not specified '***eunuchs who were made eunuchs by men***,' I'll repeat that, **BY MEN**. Jesus would have presented us with the opportunity to force gay men into lifelong celibacy and blame Him for our

actions. Jesus closed that legalistic loophole. GOD does not make gay men become eunuchs to enter His Kingdom of Heaven. According to Jesus, that force is being applied by mankind, not GOD.

Invitation 2: Jesus Teaches Us About Some Being Taken

'I tell you, in that night there will be two men in one bed: the one will be taken and the other will be left.'

- King Jesus in Luke 17:34 NKJV

This love note from GOD to His Rainbow Children has always been in plain sight, but our religious experts have refused to see it. Every Bible expert that claims to know how Jesus will return has stumbled upon this rock in their path to address their mistreatment of gays and lesbians. When I pointed out this verse, I heard excuses and justifications.

What no one tries to explain is Jesus' choice of words. If Jesus had wanted to portray two men eating next to each other, He could have done that easily without putting them in a bed together at night.

Here are some of their excuses & justifications:

1. Two men in one bed at night is grouped with normal, daily tasks of two women grinding together and two men in the field. Jesus wouldn't group a drama-filled option with two mundane ones. Therefore we can rule out that Jesus is referring to two men in a snowstorm that are huddled together for shared body warmth so they won't perish.
2. Our Bible experts have redefined the word Jesus used for bed, ***kline***, to agree with their opinions. When Jesus used the same Greek word to describe hiding our light under a bed, ***kline***, there's no confusion. Only when Jesus uses the same word to describe ***two men in it together at night*** did our Bible experts need this ***kline*** to be redefined as a couch or mat used for sleeping, sickness, sitting, or eating.
3. Matthew recorded the same discussion and he left out Jesus' words about two men in one bed at night.

'Then two men will be in the field: one will be taken and the other left. Two women will be grinding at the mill: one will be taken and the

other left. Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.'

- King Jesus in Matthew 24:38-42 NKJV

Matthew confirms that Jesus meant it exactly like Luke recorded it. Matthew was Jewish and steeped in Jewish traditions that forbade gay sex. Since Matthew didn't have a mental framework to understand these words from Jesus, he omitted them since he couldn't process how GOD could say that.

In addition, Matthew clarified that his two women were grinding together **at a mill** to make sure we didn't catch Jesus' subtle humor about lesbians.

Invitation 3: Scriptures Teach Us That GOD Married Israel & The Church is His Bride

Since GOD knows the end from the beginning, it's not surprising that He directly addressed the major controversy of same-sex marriage. GOD called Israel His Wife and Jesus' followers are His Bride. Our King Jesus couldn't make it clearer that He plans to marry us, male and female, and therefore He affirms same-sex marriages.
